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General Data Protection Regulation

The list contained below details all of the suppliers or service providers Stocksbridge Junior School has a contract with and will therefore share data with them in order for their services to be provided.

Stocksbridge Junior School remains the Data Controller whilst the suppliers, are the Data Processors. Please also refer to the Schools Privacy Notice on the website.

Stocksbridge Junior School remains committed to ensuring all data under its control is kept safe and secure. All pupils and parents can be assured that we only work with companies who are vetted and have their own policies and procedures in place to comply with GDPR.

Curriculum purposes

- Thrive Online – This system is used to assess children's social and emotional development.
- Times Table Rockstars – This is a secure online system where pupils can practice their times table recall.
- Seesaw – This is a secure online portal for children to share their work electronically with their class.
- Spag.com – This is a secure online system used for spelling, punctuation and grammar homework.
- Renaissance Reading – This is a secure online system which is used in school to assess children's reading progress.
- Tracker+ - This system gathers assessment data from SIMS to allow teachers to track progress and attainment in curriculum subjects.
- Robinwood – This is a secure online system used to upload children's name, medical and dietary needs prior to the Y6 residential trip.
- NST Tour Manager – This is a secure online portal used to upload children's name, medical and dietary needs prior to the Y5 London trip.

Communication purposes:

- ParentMail – This system is used to communicate with parents/guardians via email, text and app. Payments can be made, for example, for school dinners and school trips, using this system.
- Twitter – This social media platform is used to share school events with the wider public.
- Facebook – This social media platform is used to share school events with the wider public.

Monitoring purposes:

- Evolve – This is a secure online system to complete risk assessments for school trips.
- Meritec CPOMS – This is a secure online monitoring system to record child protection, safeguarding and wider student pastoral welfare in school.
- Anycomms – This is a secure online system to transfer information to and from the Local Authority. i.e. free school meals and SEND information.
- Welfare Call – This is a secure online system which communicates with the Local Authority for example: social services and the children and families department to collect and analyse attendance and attainment data for Looked After Children.
- Secure Access – This is a secure online system to communicate with the Local Authority and school-to-school transfer of data.
- Inventory – This system is used to sign in / out visitors, staff and children into the school building.



Photography purposes:

- Tempest School Photography – The school's professional photographer holds the digital class and individual photographs. Children's names are not shared.
