ANNOUNCEMENT

We understand that during the rising tension around the Omicron variant and the outlook for January that there are questions being raised regarding YV 2022 concerts.

COVID UPDATE

Before the holidays begin, we would like to update you about the recent changes to national guidance for those identified as a close contact of a COVID-19 positive case.

From Tuesday 14th December, a new national approach to daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 has been introduced. All adults who are fully vaccinated, and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, who are identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 – whether Omicron or not – should take a lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Daily testing by close contacts will help to slow the spread of COVID-19, help protect education settings by reducing transmission and, will also help keep pupils in face-to-face education.

Once notified by NHS Test and Trace or following exposure to a confirmed positive COVID case, all contacts should take an LFD each day for 7 days and report the results through the <u>Online Reporting System</u> and to school.

If the test is negative, they can continue to attend school. Outside of school, close contacts should continue to follow the advice set out in the <u>Sunday 12 December press release</u>. This approach should also be adopted over the winter break and on return in January.

If they test positive, they should self-isolate and immediately <u>order a PCR test</u> to confirm the result. If the PCR is positive, they must self-isolate for 10 days. If the PCR test is negative, they no longer need to self-isolate but should continue to carry out the remainder of the daily LFD tests, and only need to isolate if it is positive or they start to develop symptoms. If at any time anyone starts to develop symptoms, they should isolate and take a PCR test (even if they have already recently taken a PCR test or their LFD is negative).

Please help us in following the guidance so we can keep our community as safe and well as possible.
